EDUCATIONAL FIELD TRIPS

Interpretative Walk

On the walk with Tundra and Meshach, I will explain the concepts of keystone species, trophic cascades and will show examples of each. Also, will explain their wolf behaviour that they will display and why it is important in the wild.

Walk on the Beach

The walk on the beach will further allow the participants to observe Tundra and Meshach in their natural state as they explore the beach.

Wolf videos

Short wolf videos will be shown to the participants explaining the valuable role wolves play in the ecosystem. Also power point presentations will expand on these concepts.



Program Highlights

Spend a fascinating day with Meshach, Tundra, Nahanni and Mahikan. Tundra is pictured in the snow and Nahanni and Mahikan, are the 5 week old pups below. All are very high content wolf (over 90%) with Nahanni being an Arctic wolfdog, and Tundra and Mahikan come from the Occidentalist subspecies of the gray wolf.

Through Tundra's School Program, Tundra and I have visited over 130 schools in BC, seeing over 19,000 students, teaching them about wolves and allowing the students to interact with Tundra.

Participants will learn about the valuable role wolves play in the

ecosystem. They will be taught such concepts as trophic cascades, keystone species, and how wolves are ecological engineers (how wolves change rivers).
